



1) PASS A BUDGET ON TIME OR LOSE PAY

The Governor and Legislature will permanently lose their salary every day after the budget deadline until a budget is passed.

2) REFORM THE BUDGET PROCESS

Reduces the votes required in the Legislature to pass the budget and related tax legislation from 2/3rds to 55%.

3) END POLITICAL GRIDLOCK

Discourages political parties from punishing legislators for voting their conscience.

4) MAKE BUDGET LEGISLATORS' TOP PRIORITY

Requires Legislature to remain in session and only work on budget related legislation until the budget is signed.

5) GIVE VOTERS THE FACTS

Adds a budget summary to the Official Ballot Pamphlet to explain how the state's money is being spent.

6) RAINY DAY FUND FOR HARD TIMES

Requires the state to sets aside a "rainy day" fund of at least 5% in good times so that budget cuts and tax increases will be less likely in challenging economic times.
