As you may know, Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger has proposed significant budget cuts to the California State University system. If enacted, the cuts will significantly reduce enrollment, decrease the number of students eligible for financial assistance, decrease the availability of financial aid grants, and increase student fees.

I am writing to inform you of an opportunity to get involved, on a voluntary basis, in an effort that is being led by the California Faculty Association (CFA). The CFA is forming an alliance to create a single voice and cooperative response in opposition of the budget cuts.
